7	UNIT 9 Physical geography	Identifies and describes physical features of Mexico including its climate, and natural resources.
8	History and culture	Identifies and describes the independence process of Mexico and the importance of Benito Juárez.
9	Mexico today	Explains the characteristics of the government and the economy of Mexico nowadays including problems that make people to cross border of the USA.
10	UNIT 10 Physical geography	Compares and contrasts the physical features of Central America and the Caribbean Islands.
11	Central America	Identifies and describes key elements in economy and agriculture from each country of Central America.
12	The Caribbean Islands	Summarizes about the early history about the Caribbean Islands and their independence process. Identifies and explains key culture features such as: customs, religions and languages.
13	UNIT 10 Physical Geography	Names and represents the physical features shared by Venezuela, Brazil and Colombia.
14	Brazil	Identifies and describes key elements of Brazil' s history and culture including language and religion and colonization process.
15	Argentina, Uruguay, and Paraguay	Compares and contrast important information between Argentina, Uruguay and Paraguay.
16	Colombia, Venezuela, and the Guianas	Explaining specific information about Venezuela, Colombia and the Guianas including cultural and independence process of each country.
